Just like your favourite toy or your pet, your personal information is **YOUR PRIVATE PROPERTY** and it's important that you keep it safe!




CONFIDENTIAL

Sometimes we will write your **name**, **phone number**, or other **important information** about you on a piece of paper or type it onto a computer. This will help us to make you better.



Other times, we have to share this information with other people that we trust, but only if we really need to. This could be with other doctors, nurses, the school that you attend, or your parents and guardians.

Remember: Your **personal information** is yours! If you don't want someone sharing your personal information, you can tell us, your parents, your teacher, or your doctor. Even though you aren't an adult yet, you have the right to keep your personal information **private**.
